Year 7 & 8 - Mathletics

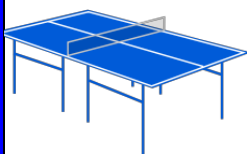
Thanks to those who have paid their \$5 for this terms Mathletics. Could we please have this paid to the office asap.
