If parents or students have any inquiries or wish to contact our service for any **urgent dental care, please contact 0800 825 583** and you will be directed to the nearest dental clinic.

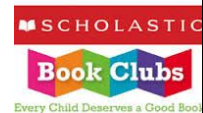
