Foxton Rugby Club Junior Muster

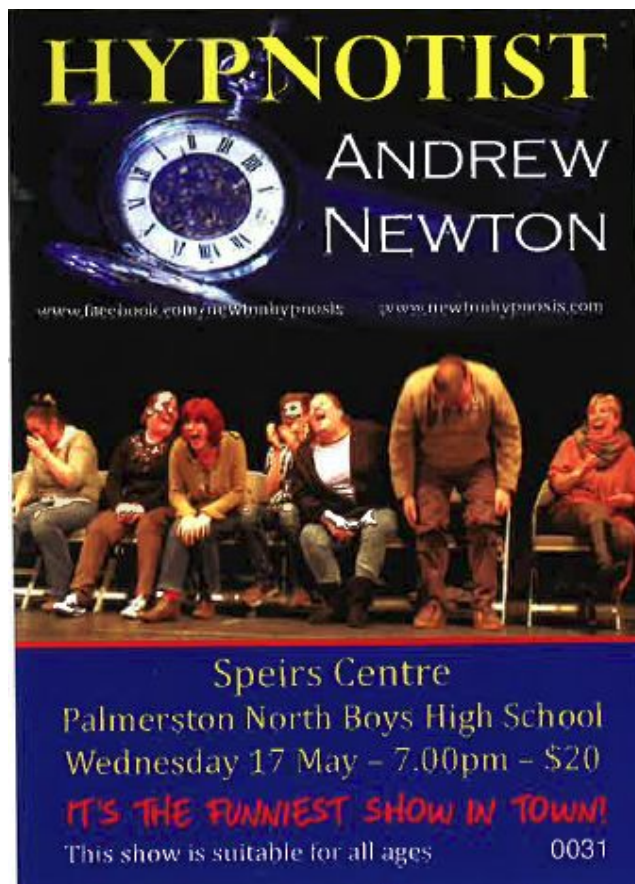
