Dear Parents,

This is a reminder to parents and whanau that please check on your children when they are playing in the school grounds after school or weekends. We often remind children of the dangers of climbing on the school roof or shade sails. We get reports from neighbours about this happening and it is a serious reminder that this week, an 8 year old boy died at a school close by in Palmerston North, by falling through the school roof. We would hate for this to happen to one of our children. The schools in Foxton all report this as a problem in their schools.

On Tuesday 28th November our Board of Trustees are funding a fun day out at the Levin Pools and then to the Levin Adventure Park for lunch and BBQ sausages. We will travel to and from Levin by bus taking 240 children at no cost to families. We will however need about 30-40 parents to help supervise on the day. Next week I will send out a newsletter /permission slip, please indicate that you can assist on the day. We will still also have our annual picnic on the last day in our school grounds (13th December)

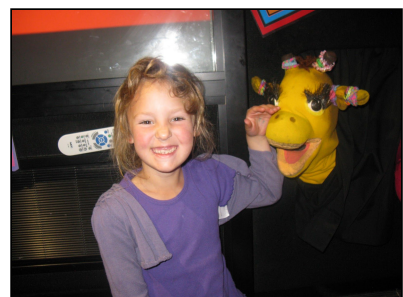
