Dear Parents,

With 2 weeks and 3 days left it seems the year has just flown by.

Tomorrow we have our trip to the Levin Pools and then adventure playground and let's hope the weather forecast is kind to us.

This Wednesday we have our final Board of Trustees meeting for the year and I wish to thank chairman Hamish Easton and our board members for their dedication to what is an important job.

One of the initiatives with the National Party was the introduction of communities of learning where schools collaborate with each other in teacher professional development and learning. Locally we have a strong community of learning and one real strength is the lack of competition for children enrolling. All schools are happy just to keep their local kids and not chase enrollments out of our area. The only school that has a zone is Foxton Beach as they have outgrown their classrooms because of the building development happening at the beach area. Coley Street School leads many of the initiatives and is extremely well staffed and resourced and we expect to grow to about 275- 280 children next year.

Currently we are waiting on the builder to arrive to start our new developments within the classrooms.
