This week all New Zealand Secondary, Primary and Early Childhood teachers have been called by our unions to **Strike on Thursday 16th March**. Coley Street School will **NOT** be open for instruction. This call to strike is something none of us take lightly but we are hoping to highlight the extreme needs that some classes are facing in our New Zealand schools. There is a general lack of relievers, numbers entering teaching are at an all time low with beginning teachers after 3 years of study being paid just above the minimum wage. This is not attracting new teachers to an already depleting workforce. We are striking for students with special needs, those affected by trauma and for the child who needs teacher aide support but does not meet the criteria for funding through the Ministry of Education. We apologise for any inconvenience this will cause. This is not an ideal situation and we hope our negotiation team is able to resolve these concerns with the Ministry soon.
