Dear Families,

This week is extremely busy, with our dance girls performing tonight at the regent theatre, starting at 6.00pm for the regionals. The girls also perform 2 more times through the week, with them entered in the Rylie Gulliver Talent Quest at Manawatu College at 6.00pm on Thursday night and then at our Hauora Day the next day.

On Thursday night we have 2 senior and 2 junior entries in the talent quest.
