From the Principal's Desk

Dear Parent / guardian,

We hope you had an enjoyable long weekend.

Yesterday 400 plus staff in our immediate region attended a 1 day workshop on trauma informed practice. This is about teachers having the understanding and knowledge to be better equipped to support students who have experienced some sort of trauma that affects their learning and concentration levels.

This is a reminder to all parents that **students should not be on the school premises until 8.15am** in the morning. Legally teachers do not have to be on the school site until then.

We are currently finding that many students are arriving from 7.30am onwards and this puts the school in a vulnerable position if a child has an accident. The classrooms will be locked until 8.15am and many schools do not unlock their gates until that stage.

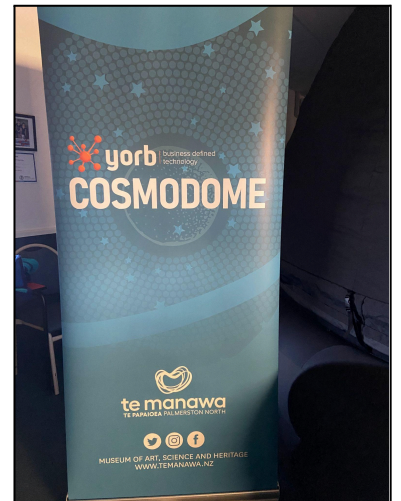
Senior Hub: Mason for using **Taha Hinengaro**, putting a real effort into his reading.
