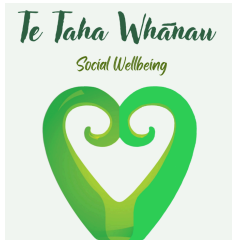
When times are tough we need to acknowledge the excellent work and positive teaching environment we have at Coley Street School.

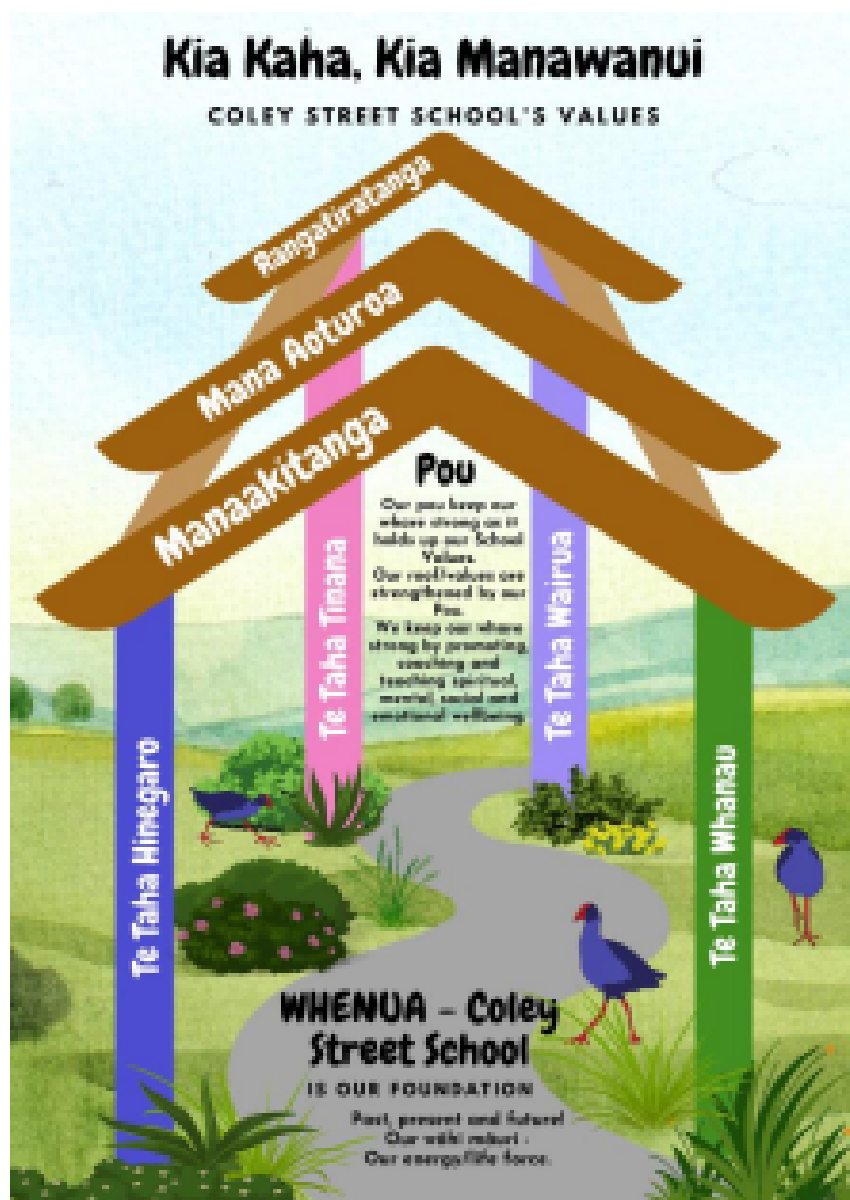
