Just a reminder that your children need to be bringing a sunhat to school each day over this term.

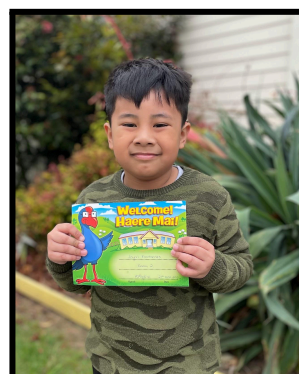
At the end of this term our Board of Trustees are investing in a large extension of our playground so watch this space.
