#### Dear Families,

Welcome back to term 2 and a special welcome to any new students and whanau.

We hope your children had a relaxing break from school and are feeling refreshed for another busy term's work.

This past set of holidays also had Easter and ANZAC Day incorporated into it.

On ANZAC Day we were represented by 10 senior leaders who participated in the Foxton Public ceremony and laid a wreath at the RSA cenotaph. Thank you to those students and parents who represented Coley Street School.

This is a reminder to parents and students that school is closed next Monday 5th May and Tuesday 6th May, so staff can attend professional development training for structured literacy, which is one of the new requirements implemented by the current government.
