### From the Principal's Desk

Kia ora koutou,

Yay it is finally Spring. I hope our students experience better health as the days get longer and the temperature starts to improve. Last week there was a day when we had 49 students away with illness.

I remember when my children were young I was often conflicted about sending them to school or not. I know children struggle to learn when they are ill and only you, the parent can make the call to have them home. The push from the Ministry for improved attendance is about absences from school for **other** reasons such as having a haircut, celebrating a birthday, going shopping or sleeping in because you are tired from being on a device late into the night. Our last attendance report said only **43**% of our students are regularly attending school with only **58**% of students being on time to class.

Over the next 3 weeks there is much happening at school. We have 'MIssy Crew' our Dance Group in the regional Dance NZ competition on Wednesday. Cross Country on Friday. Kapa haka students will be practising for performing in our community or attending the Ahurei Culture day in Levin and two Netball teams will compete in the Spring Netball Tournament

### **BOT ELECTIONS**


Coley Street School parent elections for our Board of Trustees is currently underway with the voting process. This closes at 4pm on Wednesday 10 September.
